## Old Business

### • Playground Update

- Blacktop- projecting 6-8 weeks, hoping for completion early December, weather permitting
- Once they lay the asphalt, they will open the blacktop up
- Need to lay sod in the amphitheater area
- Will hold off on planting until end of Feb./beginning of March, need to have everything completed by March 22<sup>nd</sup> to get \$100,000 from GOCO
- Lori Abram may ask for one extension
- Phase 3: Kindergarten Program
  - Latest quote: \$63,000 for smaller piece of equipment similar to big playground, removal of old equipment, and put down wood chips
  - We have about \$19,000 set aside from last year
  - Received \$2500 from Safeway/Albertsons
  - Turned down by American Furniture Warehouse, but sent a \$150 gift card which was used for Bingo raffle
  - Game Time gave the quote with a discount based on a grant that ends, but Lori is hopeful we can get a 30-40% discount
  - Lori has letters to send to companies to request donations and sponsorships
  - Let Lori know if there is a grant opportunity you are aware of.
  - Looking into a spring fundraiser to support these efforts as a final push.

## New Business

### • Teacher Grant Requests

- Devries, Brumfiel, Boiles, Mains, Bell (third grade), Lockerby

- Mains: Requesting one class set of Dell Pens so students can better access OneNote and utilize it to the full potential, will be kept in a locked cabinet, can be available for checkout as a fifth grade team.
  - Lockerby: Requesting money for Newberry Winner books: Echo, Tiger Rising (class set), Kate DiCamillo books, The Terrible Twos series wants to tie it into Project Based Learning, expose the class to really good literature.
  - Devries: Requesting noise cancelling headphones, 6 total (or more) and new move and sit cushions, 4 total
  - Third Grade: Requesting money to pay for a Hawk Quest presentation for third grade- ties into science curriculum and a project they are doing about kindness
  - Boiles: Requesting Oodle Stools- disks that sit on the floor, can be stacked and rocked and an exercise ball chair to provide opportunities for movement and choice to support student learning
  - Brumfiel: Requesting Ukuleles to complete a class set. Had a grant previously approved by the Cherry Creek Schools Foundation, needs to complete the class set.
