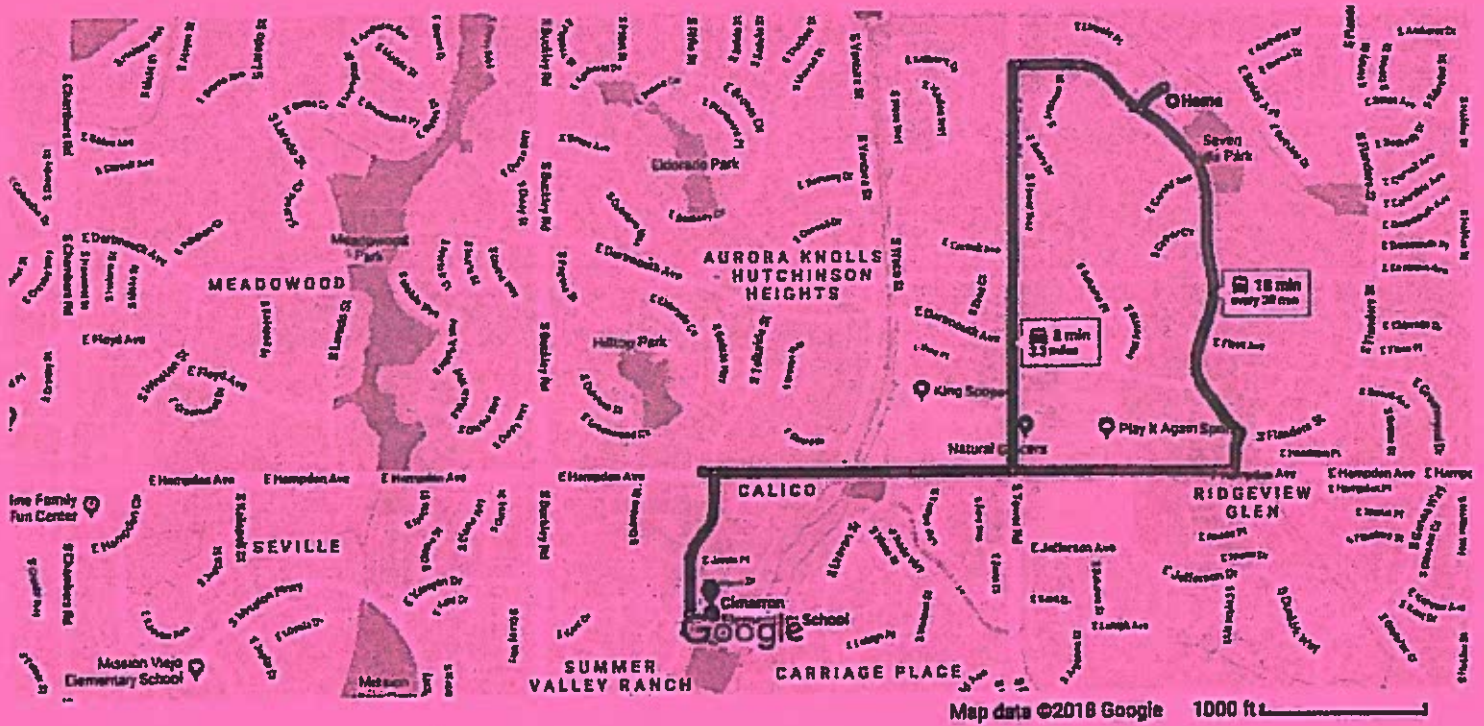

Dear Parents,

Arrowhead ECS Program's "Camp Arrowhead" is a full day childcare program that is offered throughout summer break. Camp Arrowhead will be at Cimarron Elementary School due to work being done on Arrowhead's building. Cimarron is located at 17373 E. Lehigh Pl., Aurora, CO. See map on the back side of the cover. Information on where to enter the school will be coming soon. Our phone number will remain the same, 720-886-2853.

The program will be available Monday through Friday; 6:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. Camp Arrowhead will fill the days with many fun activities including; sports, games, crafts, and exciting field trips!

This summer's theme is "STEAMing HOT Summer!" We will be doing activities centered on Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math. Most of our crafts will be using recycled materials with two on-going projects. One called "Summer House" the other called "Our Town". We will be creating a mini house and a town out of recycled materials.

Registration is exactly the same as Before & After School and should be made on SchoolCare Works Family Portal through your mycherrycreek account.

The rates shown below are for scheduled days made on or before the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month, prior to participation. After the 25<sup>th</sup>, sessions can be added at any time up until 10:00 pm the night before scheduled attendance, if space is available, with an additional fee of \$.50 per session per child.

- Walking field trips are on select Wednesdays

- No credits or refunds

**Sunscreen**

We are requesting that each family supply their own sunscreen. We would like it to be the spray kind, especially if we need to assist your child with the application. (Sign the Sunscreen Permission Form) We will have the child keep their sunscreen in their backpack, and we will let you know when another bottle is needed.

We also supply UV swim shirts for all pool days, and other water days. These shirts keep the sun off the back and shoulders, so less sunscreen is needed. These shirts, along with the field trip shirts are the property of the ECS Program. If your child takes one home, please make sure it is brought back as soon as possible.

### Walking Field Trips

We will be walking to Yo Craze and Sonic during the summer. For Yo Craze, your account will be charged the field trip fee of \$3.75 for the frozen yogurt, and for Sonic the cost is \$5.00 to cover the Kid's Meal. Hats and closed toe walking shoes should be worn for most outdoor field trips.
